Engineer Technicians perform tasks of a technical nature in connection with the investigation planning, design and construction of engineering projects.




The Engineer Technician Training Program is a 15 week, 255-hour class.



Participants selected must be available from 5-10 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays and all day Saturdays.



A passing college placement test will be required as part of the admission process.



Acceptance in training program includes enrollment in credit courses. A weekly stipend may be earned. Successful completion will result in a college-level certificate.

The program will cover selected topics in mathematics; basic engineering; surveying; construction safety, materials and testing; and Computer Aided Design and Drafting.
